## Council Tidbits

There are still twenty members who haven't submitted their annual membership dues, which are now six-months in arrears. Therefore, the "Knight Alert" letters are being forwarded with this newsletter. If you are having financial difficulties, please let us know so that other arrangements can be made. Thanks!

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This year, Council 4828's submittal for annual Bishop's Seminarian Raffle ticket sales totaled \$1005, which was 22% less than our \$1287 total from last year. However, our submittal for the state-wide "365-Club" was \$456, which was more than double last year's \$200 total. For those of you who aren't aware of the "365-Club," it was set up to encourage all Br. Knights to donate one penny per day, or \$3.65 per year, to support fellow Knights who are in need. The fund is administered by the State Council, with small donations being made to Br. Knights who are in need, on a confidential basis. Your individual donations can be forwarded to the Financial Secretary, along with your annual dues, or placed in a collection jar at our regular Council meetings. This year, the Council made up the difference between what we actually collected (\$67.50) and what we should have collected, based on \$3.65 per council member. All Council members are encouraged to participate this coming year.

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The Calendar of Events for the 2005-2006 Columbian Year is being forwarded with this newsletter. Note that there are several changes as compared to previous years. For example, our annual Installation of Officers Dinner has been moved from mid-July to the first Saturday in August and the annual Pork Feed Dinner is being replaced with an Octoberfest Dinner (we are planning chicken cordon bleu). Please put the calendar in a safe place so that you can reference it throughout the following year. If you can't make it to our regular council meetings, please try to volunteer to help with one of our many special events and fundraisers. Your help is greatly needed and appreciated.
